

	➤ PAUL DID NOT START THE CHURCH IN ROME AND HAD NOT YET VISITED
INTRODUCTION	> THE CHURCH WAS STARTED BY PILGRIMS RETURNING TO ROME FROM JERUSALEM AS NOTED IN ACTS 2
	> WRITTEN BY PAUL IN ~55AD FROM CORINTH, WRITTEN TO THE CHURCH IN THE MOST POWERFUL CITY THE WORLD HAS KNOWN
	➤ IN THE CONTEXT OF ROME'S UNASSAILABLE STATE POWER, PAUL TEACHES US TO NEVER SHRINK BACK FROM PREACHING THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST
1	➤ PAUL'S SALUTATION: "I AM NOT ASHAMED OF THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST" IS ESPECIALLY NOTEWORTHY GIVEN THE SEEMINGLY UNASSAILABLE SECULAR POWER OF THE STATE OF ROME
	➤ GOD IS REVEALED TO ALL IN CREATION
	➤ A SOCIETY DESCENDS INTO MORAL DEPRAVITY WHEN IT PUBLICLY AND PRIVATELY REJECTS ITS CREATOR

 "THEREFORE, YOU ARE WITHOUT EXCUSE, O MAN." THE MORALLY UPRIGHT GENTILE REMAINS UNDER THE POWER OF SIN DUE TO CONSCIENCE
THE JEW, DESPITE POSSESSING THE LAW AND THE COVENANT (EVIDENCED BY CIRCUMCISION), IS EQUALLY UNDER THE CONDEMNATION OF SIN
 PAUL SETS FORTH FOUR SETS OF RHETORICAL QUESTIONS TO AVOID THEOLOGICAL DISTORTIONS - THEN AND NOW A SERIES OF "NO, NOT ONE!" STATEMENTS "BUT NOW" "HE MIGHT BE JUST AND THE JUSTIFIER OF THE ONE WHO HAS


But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe.

For there is no difference; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness,

because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness,

that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. Romans 3:21-26

The doctrine of imputation manifests in three key dimensions:

- Adam's Sin Imputed to Humanity Through Adam's federal headship, his guilt is imputed to all mankind. Thus, all are born under condemnation not merely for personal sins, but because of Adam's representative transgression (Romans 5:12–19).
- Believers' Sin Imputed to Christ As Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 5:21, Christ was "made to be sin for us," though sinless. The sins of believers are legally transferred to Christ, who bore God's wrath in their place.

 Justification rests upon His substitutionary death.
- Christ's Righteousness Imputed to Believers In turn, Christ's perfect righteousness is credited to believers. They are declared righteous before God not by their works, but through faith alone (Romans 4:5–8).

Paul's repeated use of **λογίζομαι** in Romans 4 affirms that justification is a legal declaration, not moral improvement: believers stand righteous before God by the imputed righteousness of Christ alone.

	> THE CHRISTIAN'S NEW LIFE IN CHRIST NOW ENABLES A LIFE OF SERVICE AND OBEDIENCE
7	THE CHRISTIAN'S DILEMMA: "FOR WHAT I AM DOING, I DO NOT UNDERSTAND. FOR WHAT I WILL TO DO, THAT I DON'T PRACTICE; BUT WHAT I HATE, THAT I DO." (V.15)
	➤ PAUL'S ANGUISHED EXCLAMATION IS A PRAYER FOR US ALL: "WHO CAN SET ME FREE FROM THE CLUTCHES OF MY SINFUL NATURE? I THANK GOD THERE IS A WAY OUT THROUGH JESUS CHRIST OUR LORD!" (VV. 24-25)



While believers are justified at conversion, many live beneath their spiritual privilege and inheritance due to a failure to fully surrender to Christ. Believers, united to Christ, are already sanctified in principle/truth and are being sanctified in practice.

Sanctification is the inevitable fruit of saving faith. It is both definitive and progressive: believers are fully redeemed in Christ, yet not fully perfected in holiness. This is the tension of the *already* and the *not yet*.

Sin no longer reigns, yet it remains. Holiness is therefore pursued not through passivity but through Spirit-empowered effort, grounded in the gospel and dependent upon grace.

	➤ TRANSITION TO THE FOURTH MAJOR SECTION OF OUR OUTLINE - GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS IS REVEALED IN HIS SOVEREIGNTY (9:1-11:36)
	➤ PAUL GRIEVES OVER HIS JEWISH KINSMEN, WHO, THOUGH HEIRS TO THE PROMISES, REMAIN ESTRANGED FROM CHRIST. THEIR PRIVILEGES WERE INDEED WEIGHTY
9	➤ WITH ALL THESE PRIVILEGES MOST REMAIN IN UNBELIEF AND THIS BEGS THE QUESTION: HAS GOD UNFAIRLY CHANGED HIS MIND ABOUT ISRAEL? PAUL RESPONDS - IN NO WAY!
	➤ PAUL USES SEVERAL HISTORICAL EXAMPLES OF THE PATTERN THAT GOD'S REDEMPTIVE PURPOSES REST NOT ON MAN'S EXPECTATIONS, WILL, OR EFFORT - BUT ON HIS SOVEREIGN MERCY.
	THE GENTILES AND THE REMNANT HAVE ATTAINED SALVATION BY FAITH. ISRAEL, WHO PURSUED RIGHTEOUSNESS BY EFFORT, STUMBLED ON THEIR CORNERSTONE - WHICH IS CHRIST.

The <u>doctrine of the remnant</u> is a deeply rooted biblical theme that underscores God's sovereign preservation of a faithful people within a broader context of apostasy and judgement. In Romans 9–11, Paul develops this doctrine with theological clarity and redemptive-historical depth, showing that God's purposes and promoses have not failed despite Israel's widespread unbelief.

	> THE UNIVERSAL PROCLAMATION OF GOD'S MESSAGE PRESUMES GENTILE INCLUSION AND JEWISH RESISTANCE DURING THE TIMES OF THE GENTILES.
	➤ AND HOW SHALL THEY BELIEVE IN HIM OF WHOM THEY HAVE NOT HEARD? AND HOW SHALL THEY HEAR WITHOUT A PREACHER? ROMANS 10:15

ROMANS	HEADLINES
	➤ "HAS GOD CAST AWAY HIS PEOPLE?" WITH fIRM RESOLVE, PAUL REPLIES, "CERTAINLY NOT" (ROMANS 11:1).
	➤ REMINDER OF ELIJAH'S DESPAIR AND THE REAFFIRMATION THAT GOD HAS ALWAYS PRESERVED A REMNANT ACCORDING TO HIS ELECTION BY GRACE THROUGH FAITH.
11	➤ PARTIAL BLINDNESS HAS COME UPON ISRAEL UNTIL THE FULLNESS OF THE GENTILES HAS COME IN V.25
	➤ PAUL'S ILLUSTRATION OF THE OLIVE TREE WITH SOME NATURAL BRANCHES BROKEN OFF, WHILE WILD BRANCHES ARE GRAFTED IN.

	> PAUL'S PASSAGE ON GOVERNMENT STANDS AS ONE OF THE MORE DISCUSSED AND, AT TIMES, CONTROVERSIAL SECTIONS IN PAULINE TEACHING.
	➤ PAUL'S ADMONITION - "LET EVERY SOUL BE SUBJECT TO THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES" MUST BE TAKEN IN CONTEXT WITH PAUL'S QUALIFIER - "FOR THERE IS NO AUTHORITY EXCEPT FROM GOD," AND WITHIN THE CONTEXT OF THE CORPUS OF SCRIPTURE.
13:1-7	> PAUL VIEWS GOVERNMENTS AS AGENTS OF GOD'S ORDER IN SOCIETY, WHETHER THEY REALIZE IT OR NOT.
	THERE ARE LIMITS TO GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITY - ESPECIALLY WHEN WE LOOK AT LESSONS FROM DANIEL, A FEW OF HIS FRIENDS, JOHN THE BAPTIST, AND MOST NOTABLY THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS.

	ROMANS 14 SHIFTS INTO ONE OF THE MORE NUANCED YET IMPORTANT DISCUSSIONS IN THE NEW TESTAMENT: HOW BELIEVERS ARE TO RELATE WHEN THEY DIFFER IN MATTERS OF CONSCIENCE.
	TRUE HOLINESS GROWS NOT FROM LISTS BUT FROM LOVE, NOT FROM PRESSURE BUT FROM FAITH - FAITH THAT IS OBSERVABLE IN DAILY LIFE.

15	THE COMMAND TO RECEIVE <i>ONE ANOTHER</i> ECHOES THE OVER 50 OTHER ONE ANOTHERS IN THE NEW TESTAMENT.
	➤ PAUL REFERENCES SIGNS AND WONDERS AS CONFIRMING THE MESSAGE OF THE GOSPEL - NOT AS ENDS IN THEMSELVES.
	➤ PAUL'S REVEALS HIS EVANGELISM STRATEGY - TO PREACH CHRIST WHERE HE HAS NOT YET BEEN NAMED.
	WITH HIS FOUNDATIONAL WORK COMPLETED IN THE EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN, PAUL DISCLOSES HIS INTENT TO TRAVEL TO SPAIN VIA ROME
